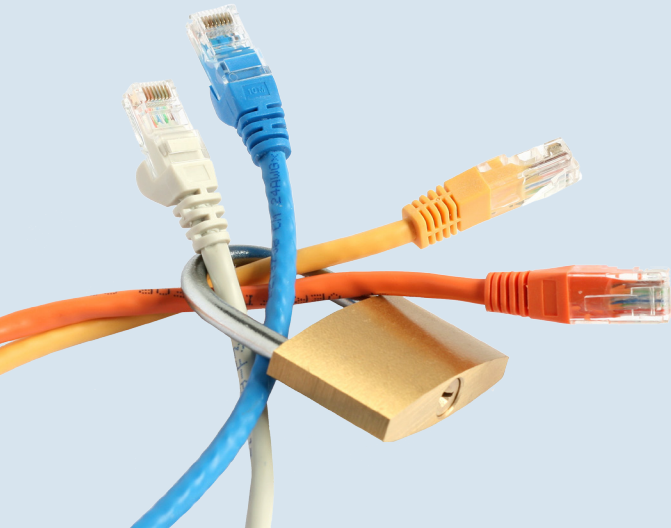

ABOUT NETWORK SECURITY ENGINEER

Network Security Engineer program graduates perform a wide variety of technical duties. In roles such as network administrator and network specialist, they maintain network hardware and software.

Network specialists analyze, design, install, test, and support systems such as local area networks (LANs), and wide area networks (WANs), Internet, intranet, and other data communications systems. They provide day-to-day on-site administrative support for network users in a variety of work environments. Network administrators also may plan, coordinate and implement network security measures.
